| 1 | heterosexual | 10 | An umbrella term for people whose gender identity differs from what is typically associated with their biological sex. |
| 2 | bisexual | 11 | An umbrella term describing people born with biological characteristics that can't be classified as typically male or female. |
| 5 | lesbian | 9 | The experience of a person's biological sex conflicting with their gender identity. Experienced by many people who identify as transgender. |
| 4 | gay | 6 | An adjective used to describe people who do not experience sexual attraction. |
| 5 | pansexual | 5 | An adjective used to describe people whose sexual, romantic or emotional attraction towards others is regardless of their sex or gender identity. |
| 6 | asexual | 2 | A person who is physically, romantically, and/ or emotionally attracted to those of the same gender or to those of another gender. |

7 sex	8 A person's internal, deeply held sense of identity with respect to being a man or woman. (womanness & feminine traits/manness & masculine traits/ lack of these traits)
8 gender	4 The adjective used to describe people whose physical, romantic, and/ or emotional attractions are to people of the same gender
9 gender dysphoria	12 Term used by some people who experience their gender identity beyond the categories of man and woman.
10 transgender	1 An adjective used to describe people whose physical, romantic, and/ or emotional attraction is to people of the opposite gender.
11 intersex	7 A woman who is physically, romantically, and/or emotionally attracted to other women.
12 gender non-binary	7 The biological classification (assigned at birth) of a person as male, female, or intersex usually based on genitals (biological characteristics).
