It's not easy being a teenager. Even outside of school, the pressure is on, and issues like self-esteem, competition, and relationships add to the noise. This is why real friendships and trusted mentors are important, and the values and support of Jewish community can be a positive guiding force. And this is why Moving Traditions created Tzelem.

Once a month, in small peer groups with trained adult mentors, LGBTQ+ teens bond and have open conversations in a safe space. Tzelem has a positive and lasting impact on teens, empowering them to become strong Jewish adults.

Groups are designed to be flexible, meeting either online or in person.
