Kumi Justice Retreats is for 9-12th graders from across the country to learn about social justice while building leadership skills and creating a multiracial Jewishly-diverse community of belonging. Participants learn skills to interrupt racism, antisemitism, and create inclusive Jewish communities in their own schools, youth groups, synagogues, and eventually college campuses. Each semester includes an in-person retreat, along with monthly virtual gatherings.

Grounded in racial justice best practices, participants engage both together and in affinity spaces for Jews of Color Empowerment and for Anti-Racist Allies, allowing for meaningful learning, reflection, and support.
